





WHO: Any child who will be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2024.

WHAT: Kindergarten Round-Up (Introduction to the school experience)

Basic Information

- Kindergarten is a full day program
- Child must be 5 years of age on or before August 1, 2024
- Registration occurs at your child's neighborhood school (or the school where you have an <u>approved</u> transfer)
 - Online Registration and details are available
 - on CCSchools website at https://www.canoncityschools.org/parents/kindergartenroundup
 - at neighborhood school
 - at District Office
- Kindergarten orientation occurs in small groups during the first week of school

 Each school will identify details and date your child is to attend.
- Students, who meet eligibility requirements, may
 - Ride district bus transportation
 - o Receive breakfast and lunch at reduced/free pricing
- Students who wish to attend a school other than their neighborhood school need to complete a transfer request. Deadline for 2024-25 school year is April 1, 2024. Transfer requests for kindergarten students will not be approved until August.
 - Transfer applications are available at the schools or at Cañon City Schools District Office, located at 101 N. 14th Street
 - Transfer requests received after the April 1st deadline will be put on a waiting list to be considered after August Registration

Registration Checklist for Kindergarten Roundup

The following items are needed to register for Cañon City Schools kindergarten:

- □ Basic information regarding child
 - Address (Proof of address required (e.g. utility bill, tax document, rental agreement, etc.)
 - Phone Number(s)
 - Parent/Guardian
 - Emergency contact information
 - Preschool program information
 - Parent/Guardian Employment Information
- Birth Certificate (official proof of birth date / legal name)
- □ Immunization record





Parents can help children be successful in kindergarten by fostering the following skills.

Practical Skills

- 1. States age (if shows fingers, counts them)
- 2. Can find first name within the classroom such as on the cubby, desk, etc.
- 3. Appropriately names the colors Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Purple, Blue, Brown, Black, White

Listening/Speaking

- 1. Listens attentively without interrupting (Attends to story for appropriate lengths of time up to 10 minutes; in group settings actively listens without interruption to the speaker)
- 2. Follows three-part related directions
- 3. Speaks in complete sentences and stays on topic
- 4. Expresses personal needs and asks for items needed for work and play

Health/Physical Development

- 1. Exhibits large muscle skills -- balancing, hopping, skipping, galloping, throwing, catching (balances on either foot for at least 5 seconds; hopping on either foot for at least 5 seconds; galloping -not running)
- 2. Uses pencil/crayons adequately for this level of development (uses 3 to 4 finger grasp at lower portion of the pencil or crayon with control)
- 3. Uses scissors adequately (holds scissors correctly, cuts away from the body and cuts on a line)

<u>Math</u>

- 1. Counts with one to one correspondence up to 10
- 2. Can name 4 shapes (circle, rectangle, square, and triangle)

Group and Personal Interaction

- 1. Follows classroom/school rules
- 2. Actively participates with peers in work and play
- 3. Uses appropriate voice levels (Uses "inside" and "outside" voices when and where appropriate)
- 4. Practices self-control (consistently waits for turn, delays gratification, aware of others space, controls impulsivity)
- 5. Works independently (stays on task, completes work by self and seeks assistance when needed)
- 6. Completes tasks in a timely manner
- 7. Takes pride in doing a careful job with projects and daily work
- 8. Has adequate attention span (5 to 10 minutes)

FREE AND REDUCED MEAL APPLICATIONS:

Free and reduced meals are available to students whose families qualify. Part of what makes our program successful is having free and reduced applications on file for all district students. Free and Reduced Meal Applications for the 2024-2025 school year will be available at all schools during registration and also online in July. There will also be applications available at the District Administration Office after July 1st 2024. If you feel there is a possibility that your family may qualify for meal benefits, please pick up an application and return it to your child's school or the Administration Building prior to the beginning of the 2024-2025 school year. We will notify your family of any benefit eligibility. We need just one application per family. All children in the family attending Cañon City Schools should be listed on one application.
