Traffic Update

I want to thank Lincoln families for their patience every day at dismissal. Here are a few reminders:

- Just a reminder that the west parking lot is reserved for staff only, so that pedestrians can travel safely through that area without cars backing out or turning around at dismissal time.
- Please be respectful of where you park in the neighborhoods around the school, so as not to block residents' driveways.
- Work has begun on the east side of the campus to build a new parking lot! Our plan is to add a minimum of 16 additional parking spots that will hopefully relieve a lot of the traffic congestion around the school each day.
- In the pick up lane (old bus lane), please make sure you **continually** move your vehicle forward against the curb while you wait for your student. This will help alleviate congestion on Myrtle that is waiting to pull in. We want to avoid large gaps between cars in that area if possible.
