

CCEA Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance for advanced educational opportunities to a student seeking a career in education.

The scholarship amount will be \$500.00 and may be used at any accredited vocational school or accredited institution of higher learning. The scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, resident hall expenses and travel expenses.

Applicant must:

- 1. Have graduated from an accredited high school.
- 2. Have been accepted to an accredited post-secondary institution.
- 3. Enter a program that will lead to a diploma or certificate.
- 4. Demonstrate a commitment to the pursuit of advanced learning.
- 5. Show evidence of the character and citizenship traits, which would indicate the maturity necessary to succeed in a higher education environment.
- 6. Complete the enclosed application and submit it to the counseling office by their stated deadline.
- 7. If selected, send a written letter communicating to CCEA about your learning experience.

This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of your desire to pursue a career in teaching and your outstanding character.

Selection of the recipient will be made by the CCEA Scholarship Committee and voted upon by the membership of the scholarship committee present. An alternate will be named in the event the original recipient is unable to take advantage of the scholarship. If no recipient is selected the award will be extended to the following year.

Upon receiving a copy of the college/university acceptance letter, a check in will be presented to the recipient.
