



Canon City Noon Lions Club Academic Scholarship

The Canon City Noon Lions Club will award a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 to a qualified graduating senior from Canon City. The Scholarship Funds may be used for tuition or other expenses involved in educational advancement.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Each applicant must be a graduating senior from Canon City High School
2. Applicants must be pursuing acceptance or have been accepted into any accredited college, university, or other institution of higher learning.
3. The primary considerations for the scholarship awarded will be based on the following factors: history of completed community service, GPA, intended field of study, character, and citizenship.

Selection and Administration Procedures

1. Selection of a recipient and alternate will be made by the Canon City Noon Lions Scholarship Committee.
2. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student upon written confirmation of enrollment in the accredited program.
3. These three applicants will be required to attend one of the club's general meetings (usually on Tuesdays at 12:00 noon) and speak to the club for approximately 5 minutes, elaborating on their application and explaining their future plans, as well as answering any questions from the club members. The club will then vote in private and decides which one of the candidates will be awarded the scholarship.
4. Deadline: completed applications should be turned into the school office not later than **March 25th, 2021**.
