



Canon City Noon Lions Club Career and Technical Education Scholarship

The Canon City Noon Lions Club will award a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 to a qualified graduating senior from Canon City High School pursuing a career in Career or Technical Education. Some examples of such careers are nursing, health tech, cosmetology, auto mechanics, welding, electrician, plumbing, HVAC, carpentry, culinary arts, heavy equipment. The Scholarship Funds may be used for tuition or other training expenses including room and board.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Each applicant must be a graduating senior from Canon City High School
2. Applicants must be pursuing acceptance or have been accepted into any accredited junior/community college, accredited trade school, and/or accredited on-line programs.
3. The primary considerations for the scholarship will be: history of completed community service, clear career goals, experience in field of interest, GPA of 2.0 or above, and character and citizenship.

Selection and Administration Procedures

1. Selection of a recipient will be made by the Canon City Noon Lions Scholarship Committee.
2. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student upon written confirmation of enrollment in the accredited program.
3. The recipient will be required to attend one of the club's general meetings (usually on Tuesdays at 12:00 noon) and speak to the club for approximately 5 minutes, elaborating on his/her application and explaining future plans, as well as answering any questions from the club members. Deadline: completed applications should be turned into the school office no later than **March 25th, 2021.**
