

FRANK M. HICKEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:

The Frank M. Hickey (1894 - 1987) Memorial Scholarship honors a man who spent more years of service at Canon City High School than any other faculty member who ever served the cause of education in Canon City. He served not only CCHS as a coach, teacher, and principal, but also the community in so many ways. Active in service clubs, Chamber of Commerce, American Red Cross and fund drives of every sort, he was particularly dedicated to the youth of Canon City. The classes of 1920 through 1962 are proud to honor him with a perpetual scholarship fund. The amount of the scholarship will be at least \$2,000.

SELECTION AND ADMINISTRATION PROCEDURES:

1. Each applicant must be a graduating senior of Canon City High School and must rank in the upper 20% of the graduating class.
2. Candidates for this scholarship shall have been accepted to any four year or accredited university in Colorado.
3. Each applicant must enter a program which would lead to a four-year degree.
4. All applicants must take one of the following tests: The American College Test (ACT), or the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT).
5. Each applicant must be a citizen of the United States, living in the Canon City School District two years before graduating from high school.
6. There are no restrictions on race, color, creed or sex.
7. Each applicant must show the character, citizenship, and dependability traits, which would indicate success in college.
8. Each applicant must show evidence of broad interests and participation in activities in school and/or community.
9. This scholarship will be awarded without regard to financial Need. If all other things are equal, then need may be considered.
10. The Canon City High School Scholarship Committee shall select three candidates for this scholarship and shall submit applications to the Frank Hickey Scholarship Committee.
11. The recipients of the scholarship will receive a check upon confirmation of the enrollment from the admitting school or the scholarship will be written out to the college or university and deposited to the student's account.
12. In the event the recipient of the award shall not have enrolled in college by December 1 of the following school year, an alternative will receive the award, following the same procedure by February 1 or the award will be held over for the next year.
13. If no candidate meets the above requirements, no award will be made. Funds will be carried over to the next year.

1. Transcript of academic record.
2. List of extra-curricular activities and/or activities or work experience outside of school.
3. Three (3) letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from a teacher.
 - b. One from an adult
 - c. One from another adult or employer of your choice.
4. A personal letter from the applicant to the Scholarship Committee.
5. A recent photo of the applicant.
