This is to notify you that we are accepting applications from Cañon City High School students for our scholarship. Please have potential students complete and return the attached Application to your Guidance Office or our P. O. Box 1032. Due to the time needed for interviewing and selecting students, the final date that we will accept applications is **Thursday March 25, 2021, the same deadline as CCHS.**

We are a group of local professionals serving on a voluntary basis who have joined together to make available financial assistance in the form of a renewable scholarship to student(s) with the following educational goals to specific types of institutions listed below.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP:

This RENEWABLE scholarship amounts to \$2,400.00 for one or more student(s) paid directly to the student at the rate of \$300.00 per semester. Attendance must be continuous and scholarship payments are limited to a maximum of four years. Requirements for school and curriculum of choice are: 1) the school must be an accredited Four-Year Engineering program, and 2) Field of Engineering to be student's choice.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

1. This scholarship is only for students intending to attend an accredited Engineering school,
2. Students must fill out the attached Fremont County Engineering Scholarship Foundation, Inc. Scholarship Application Form,
3. The scholarship is only available to students in Fremont County, Colorado high schools,
4. The scholarship is only available to Fremont County residents,
5. No restrictions will be invoked due to race, creed, color, or gender.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

1. The Foundation must receive the application by or before the date specified above,
2. The Foundation may require an interview with the applicant(s),
3. The recommendation by the interview committee and the selection by the Foundation is final,

4. The high school of the successful applicant will be notified in time to acknowledge the student at the schools end of year awards presentation.

DISPERSEMENT OF FUNDS:

1. The recipient of this scholarship will be required to have successfully graduated from high school,
2. Initial funds will be dispersed to the student upon receipt of proof of enrollment from the Engineering school.

RENEWAL CRITERIA:

1. Student must maintain a “C” average or better in at least 12 hours per semester,
2. The scholarship is renewable seven consecutive semesters only.
3. Funds will be dispersed to the student after receipt of grades from the previous semester,
4. If the student fails to provide proof of attendance and acceptable grades each semester, the scholarship will be terminated by the Foundation.
