

“LET THERE BE LIGHT” ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP

Applicant MUST be a FIRST GENERATION college or trade school student (no member of your family has received an A.A or B.A./B.S. degree) attending college or a trade school with the goal of earning a certificate, A.A. or B.A./B.S. degree.

The son/daughter of a member of Rotary is ineligible.

The applicant must fill out the attached form. Finalists will be interviewed by a scholarship committee as part of the application process.

This \$1,000 scholarship will renew each year until certificate/degree completion as long as criteria are met and money is available.

- a. Be enrolled as a fulltime student.
- b. Maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher.
- c. Provide the scholarship committee a college transcript at the end of the school year.
- d. Attend a yearly Rotary meeting during the summer at which time a check will be presented in the name of the college.
