

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance for advanced educational opportunities to a female student.

The scholarship amount will be \$500.00 and may be used at any accredited vocational school or accredited institution of higher learning. The scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, resident hall expenses and travel expenses.

Applicant must:

- 1. Have graduated from an accredited high school.
- 2. Have been accepted to an accredited post secondary institution.
- 3. Enter a program that will lead to a diploma or certificate.
- 4. Demonstrate a commitment to the pursuit of advanced learning.
- 5. Show evidence of the character and citizenship traits, which would indicate the maturity necessary to succeed in a higher education environment.
- 6. Complete the enclosed application and submit it to the Canon City High School counseling office by their stated deadline.
- 7. Submit 2 letters of recommendation with the application.
- 8. If selected, send a written letter communicating to the FC Chapter about your learning experience.

This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of your desire to pursue advanced learning and your outstanding character.

Selection of the recipient will be made by the P.E.O. Chapter FC Scholarship Committee and voted upon by the membership of the scholarship committee present. An alternate will be named in the event the original recipient is unable to take advantage of the scholarship.

Upon confirmation from the college registrar's office that the recipient has been accepted and enrolled, a check will be presented to the recipient at the start of the first quarter/semester after selection.
