Re: Scholarship Availability for High School Seniors & PCC Fremont Campus Students

The Royal Gorge Artists Association is pleased to be able to offer a renewable scholarship again this year. New applicants must currently be attending High School in Fremont or Custer Counties or be registered with Pueblo Community College, Fremont Campus. To be eligible, a student must major or minor in the arts (includes visual or performing arts.) The student must have a 3.0 GPA to qualify and be enrolled in an art course at an approved correspondence, art school, or college, each semester to be eligible for scholarship payment.

The scholarship will be for up to \$500 per semester, to be paid to the school upon proof of registration (including at least one art course) at the beginning of the first semester. The second payment will be made upon receipt of the student's official transcript at the end of the first semester. The student must maintain a minimum 3.0 grade average (pass/fail grade system not acceptable). It will be the responsibility of the student to see that an official transcript is sent to the above address.

Recipients may apply to RGAA for continuing scholarships throughout their art education.

Scholarship information and instructions

Eligibility: The Royal Gorge Artists Association is pleased to be able to offer a renewable scholarship again this year. New applicants must currently be attending High School in Fremont or Custer Counties or be registered with Pueblo Community College, Fremont Campus. To be eligible, a student must major or minor in the arts (includes visual or performing arts.) The student must have a 3.0 GPA to qualify and be enrolled in an art course at an approved correspondence, art school, or college each semester to be eligible for each scholarship payment. The scholarship will be for up to \$500 per semester, to be paid to the school upon proof of registration (including at least one art course) at the beginning of the first semester. The second payment will be made upon receipt of the student's official transcript at the end of the first semester. The student must maintain a minimum 3.0 grade average (pass/fail grade system not acceptable). It will be the responsibility of the student to see that an official transcript is sent to RGAA at the address below.

Recipients may apply for continuing RGAA scholarships throughout their art education.

1. Complete attached application form.

2. Attach to the application, four photos of your work including at least 4 individual works, a CD of music performance, or a DVD of dance or theatre performance.

Include the following information on each submission: Your name, address, size& description of work, (vertical direction first), title, and medium used. If you wish photos returned, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your application. PLEASE NOTE: All work submitted must be original and not copied from any source or other work of art.

Finalists will be chosen on the basis of excellence of the work submitted.

3. Statement: Attach a statement expressing your goals and reasons for wanting an education in the arts.

4. Recommendation: Attach at least one, but no more than three, letters of recommendation from your high school or other art teacher, preferably on a school letterhead. Include teacher's name, address and phone number.

5. Scholarship applications must be received by RGAA no later than **March 25th, 2021.**
